



## MPIP Physician E&M Reimbursement Update Effective 10/1/2023

The Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) published on 4/29/2024 guidance to SMMC Plans regarding the pediatric evaluation and management codes reimbursement rates applicable to Medicaid Physician Incentive Program (MPIP) provider reimbursement under the MPIP program. The General Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 (SB 2500) included an appropriation to increase reimbursement rates for physicians providing pediatric care. This includes those physicians providing pediatric care currently being paid at the Medicare rate to amounts greater than Medicare reimbursement rates. In accordance with this Act, the reimbursement rates for qualifying physicians for services rendered to members under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be made at 105.6% of the Medicare or Medicare equivalent rates. The reimbursement rates listed reflect an increase to 105.6% of the Medicare rate for services provided between October 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023 and January 1, 2024 – September 30, 2024.

In that case, corrected claims would need to be submitted to Molina for processing.**
