## Molina Healthcare Lunch and Learn: Apple Health Expansion (AHE) Medicaid

Beginning at 8:00 a.m. on June 20, the Health Care Authority (HCA) will begin accepting applications for the new Apple Health Expansion (AHE) program. Coverage will be effective on July 1, 2024.

### What is Apple Health Expansion?

The Health Care Authority (HCA) will expand health care coverage to adults with certain immigration statuses. Due to a limited budget, the HCA needs to manage the number of people who can enroll in the program to ensure clients receive the highest-value care possible.

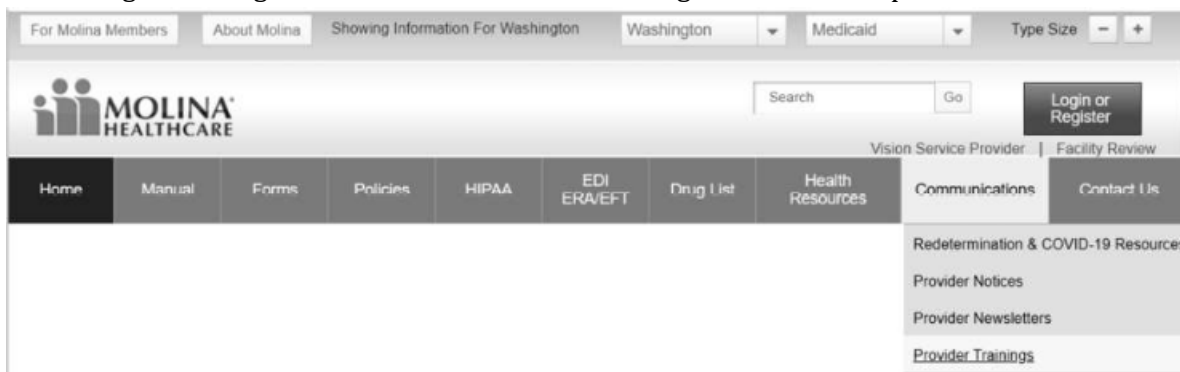
### Clients may be eligible if they:

- Are a Washington resident age 19 or older
- Have countable income under 138 percent of the federal poverty level
- Do not qualify for other Apple Health programs based on immigration status
- Are not pregnant or did not have a pregnancy end in the last 12 months, and
- Are not eligible for qualified health plans with advance premium tax credits (APTC)
