Where can I use my member rewards?

What can I buy with my rewards card?

Use your rewards to buy approved items such as:



Whole Care items:

- Eligible groceries (same as eligible foods through SNAP food stamp/ EBT benefits)
- · Over-the-counter products
- Home and personal supplies (body soap, shampoo, conditioner, cleanser, dental care, paper towels, toilet paper, paper cups, bathroom supplies, kitchen cleaner, dishwasher detergent, fan, air conditioner, space heater)
- **Bill pay** (pay monthly expenses like electric, heating, gas, sanitation, water, sewer, internet, and phone services)
- Pest control
- Assistive devices (grab bars, raised toilet seats, bedroom safety aids)
- · Pet care and supplies
- Disaster recovery supplies
- Non-medical transportation



<u>Baby items</u>: (Only eligible through earned Pregnancy Rewards)

- Infant diapers
- Baby wipes
- Pack-n-play*

- Toddler pull-ups
- Baby formula
- Car seat*



^{*}Items can only be purchased at Walmart online or in-store.

NOTE:

Although your rewards can be used to buy thousands of approved items, there are products that do not qualify. Your rewards cannot be used to buy alcohol, tobacco, or firearms; or used at an ATM to get cash or any cash transaction. Other exclusions include personal wellness items like bubble bath, bath bombs, body sprays/fragrances, cosmetics, cosmetic applicators, makeup removers, nail polish and sexual health/STD prevention.
