

Maternal Infant Health Program (MIHP) Revisions

In accordance with State of Michigan guidelines, Molina Healthcare of Michigan will incorporate the following provisions for the Maternal Infant Health Program:

- Only one assessment is allowed per pregnancy and per infant.
- Reimbursement is allowed for one professional visit per beneficiary per date of service, regardless of place of service.
- Maternal beneficiaries are only allowed up to **nine** professional visits per pregnancy.
- Infant beneficiaries are allowed up to **nine** professional visits. With an accompanying physician order, infant beneficiaries may receive an additional nine visits (for a total of 18). Providers should indicate they have a physician order using the MDHHS 5650 Communication Form. Providers should retain documentation of either the Communication Form or the Physician Order in their medical records.
- For beneficiaries with a diagnosis of drug-exposed infant, these beneficiaries may receive the previously mentioned 18 visits, plus an additional 18 visits (for a total of 36 visit) with a physician order indicating this diagnosis and using the drug-exposed procedure code(s). Providers should indicate they have a physician order using the MDHHS 5650 Communication Form. Providers should retain documentation of either the Communication Form or the Physician Order in their medical records.

Please ensure you are reviewing the MDHHS Provider Manual and MIHP Operations Guide for specific age requirements before rendering and billing for services.
